1. Getting Started

Socials Bytes Plugin requires PHP 5.3+ and Wordpress 3.2+. This plugin allows you to display your social networks counts inside your Wordpress site. It has a lot of features listed below:

- Wordpress Widget
- Wordpress Shortcode
- Shorcode Generator Page
- 6 beautiful themes optimize for any size of widget area and any background
- 8 Networks available
 - Facebook
 - Twitter
 - Vimeo
 - Youtube
 - Feedburner
 - Envato Marketplaces (referral links supported)
 - Digg
 - Dribbble

2. Plugin Installation

When you are ready to install the plugin, you must first to upload the plugin files and active the plugin itself. The files can be uploaded in two ways:

- **FTP Upload:** Using your FTP client, upload the **non-zipped** plugin folder ("**socials-bytes-plugin**") into the `/wp-content/plugins` folder on your server.
- **WordPress Upload:** Navigate to `Plugins > Add New > Upload`. Go to browse and select the **zipped** plugin folder. Hit "Install Now" and the plugin will be uploaded and installed.

Once the plugin is installed, you need to activate it. Go to Plugins and activate the *Socials Bytes* plugin.


3. The Widget

Once the plugin is installed and activated, go to the [Wordpress Widgets](#) page and inside the "Available Widgets" you will find the *Socials Bytes Widget*: drag and drop it inside any Widget Area you want.

Expand the widget and fill all options you want set. Click Save button to confirm changes.

Note: if the social networks ids are incorrect or the relative API returns an error the plugin does not show the relative social icon.

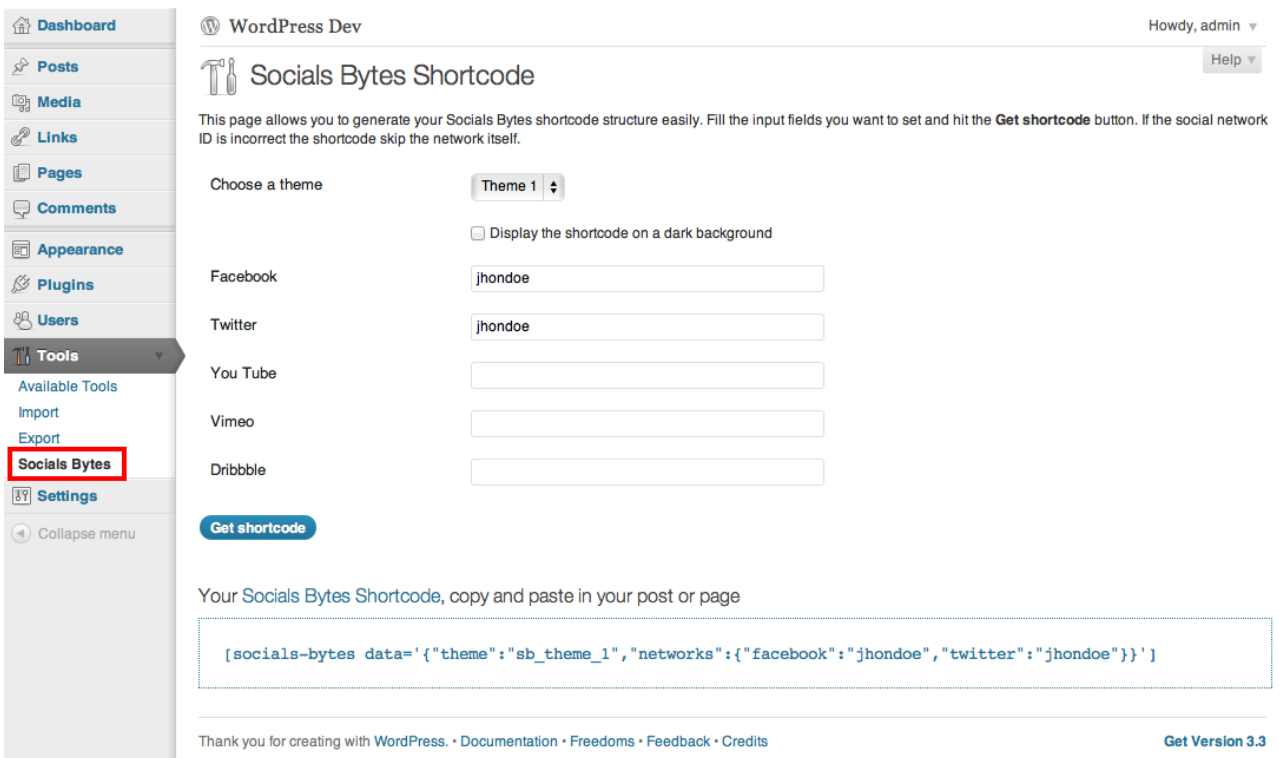
4. The Shortcode

Socials Bytes Plugin offers you a Wordpress Shortcode also. It allows you to display your socials bytes wherever you want, like inside a post or a page. The code structure of the shortcode is simple. It takes one argument only. It is a **Json string** that contains all the same data you can set in the widget.

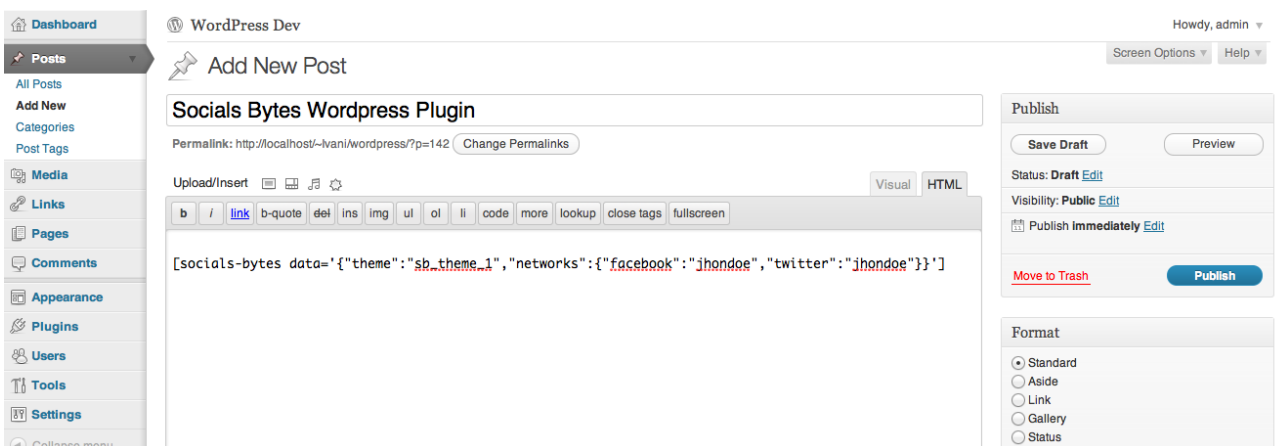

[socials-bytes data='the json string with all configurations']
```

It's a long and boring process to write the json string for data and there is a high probability to make mistakes, so the plugin has a **shortcode generator page** which creates all shortcode structure without any typing errors. Simply copy and paste the generated string inside a post or a page of your website.

The Shortcode Generator page is located inside the *Tools* menu of WP admin area.

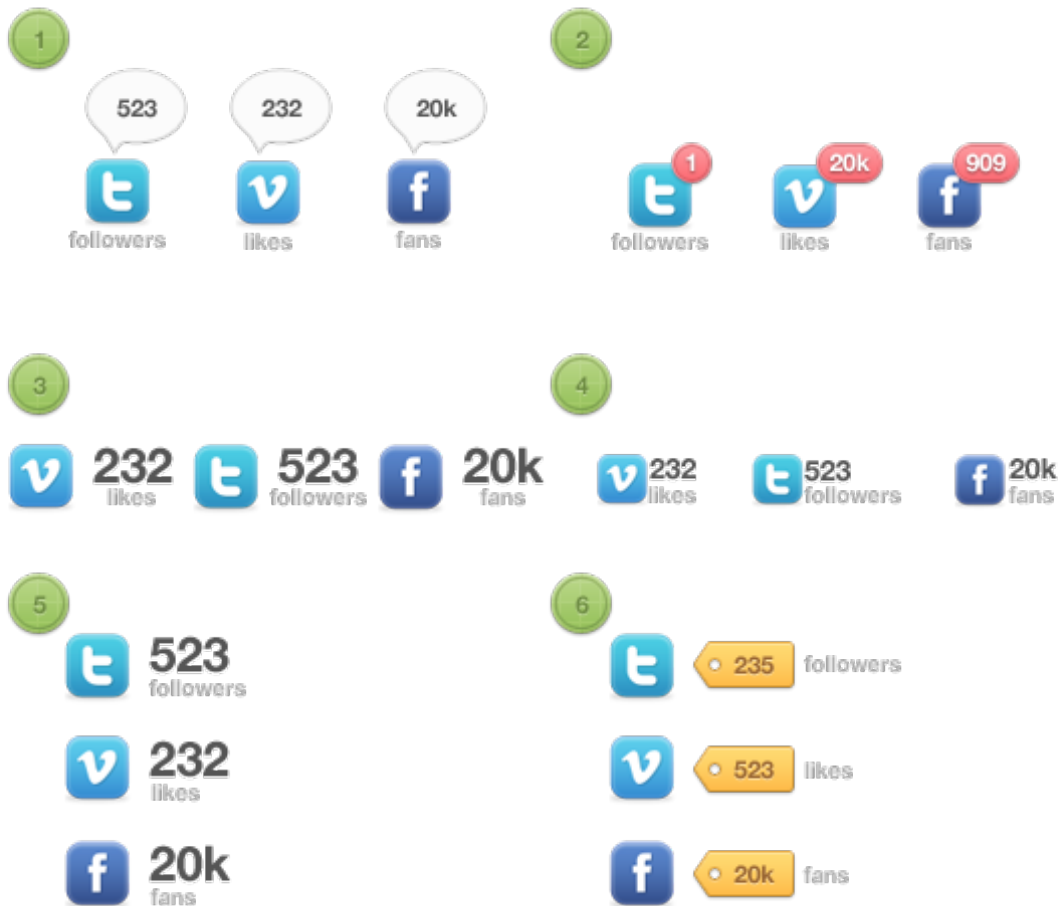


When all fields are set, hit the *Get shortcode* button. Copy and paste the generated code in your post or page. So easy!! ;-)
